Church Council met on Sunday, April 11th and made the following decisions that affect our congregation.

1. **LOVING GROUP** can begin meeting again with catered meals in the Parish Life Center. Join us on May 25th to assemble the June Proclaimer and share a meal & fellowship!
2. **MEALS.** We can resume congregational meals with the following provisions:
  - all folks will wear masks to receive food.
  - only catered or prepackaged food allowed. No pot luck meals. Servers will wear masks & gloves.
  - in addition to our normal disposable plates and cups, we are being asked to use prepackaged utensils. Thank you to those who have already brought some. More are needed to keep our expenses down.
3. **HOMECOMING** will **not** be held in May, but Council suggested that the Homecoming Committee consider a date later in the year.
4. **MASKS.** Effective immediately, masks may be removed once you are seated in your pew. Council requests that we continue to wear our masks while entering and exiting the sanctuary, while moving around inside the sanctuary, while coming forward for Holy Communion, and while singing. Ushers are being asked to help remind us.
5. **FULL-TIME YOUTH/YOUNG ADULT DIRECTOR** position and compensation package was presented by Staff Support and approved by Council. This must also have our congregation's approval. Council has called a special Congregational Meeting Sunday, May 16th to vote on this addition to our budget.
6. **SPECIAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING** will be held Sunday, May 16th at 10 am in the Sanctuary to vote on item #5 above.
