WORSHIP DETAILS FOR JUNE 21, 2020

Wow! We're going to be back in the building this weekend! Very exciting!! In an effort to keep everyone safe, here are some things you need to know.

1. Yes, the service will be video-taped and will be on **YouTube** as soon as possible on Sunday.
2. We will **not have Communion** this week. There are so many logistics involved that we will save that one until later.
3. We will not have congregational **singing**. We will instead have some choir members lead the singing and we can follow along with the words. We will also have special music.
4. We will not have **Sunday School** or nursery.
5. We will have **overflow** rooms available if necessary.
6. The **bulletin** will be one page front and back with the order of service and important announcements only. Please bring your **Bible** as there will not be room for printing the scripture. The LBW will be there for your use in both services.
7. The **8:30 service** will meet in the Nave with seating on every other row. We encourage everyone to enter through the main front doors where your temperature will be taken before entering. Ushers will be happy to assist you in finding room for your family to sit together for worship.
8. The **11:00 service** will meet in the PLC with chairs properly spaced. Folks who park in the back will need to enter through the double doors close to the cemetery, NOT through the kitchen door. Folks who park in the front will enter through the main PLC doors. Everyone will have their temperature taken before entering the PLC. Ushers will be happy to assist you in finding room for your family to sit together for worship.
9. **Masks** should be worn on entry and exit and are recommended, but not required, during the service. We will have a few masks available if you do not have your own.
10. **Dismissal** from services will be usher led to reduce contamination.
11. **Reservations** are encouraged as we have limited seating to maintain social distancing. It will also serve as our **attendance list** should any problems arise.
12. **Hand Sanitizing** stations are at each entrance for your convenience.
13. **Restrooms** will have Clorox wipes & trash cans outside so that you can wipe down what you touched and put the used wipe in the trash can afterwards.
