Let's Celebrate Pasta!

Pasta's origins are ancient. Contrary to popular belief however, Marco Polo did not discover pasta in Asia & bring it to Italy. It was eaten as early as 1279 a.d. Early Romans used a very simple flour & water dough. *Pasta* is the Italian word for dough.

Thomas Jefferson introduced pasta to the Americas after first tasting it in Naples, Italy. He was the American Ambassador to France at the time. In 1789, he brought the first pasta machine, along with crates of macaroni, back to the U.S. Pasta became common in the U.S. in the late 19th century with the surge in Italian immigration.

Fresh pasta is not necessarily better than dried pasta, it's just that it's *made* differently & it *tastes* different. Dry pastas are made with just wheat and water. Fresh pastas add egg to the dough.

If you have never made your own pasta, you should try it! It's fun & yummy! My dad used to make it quite often. Hint: you'll need a long table when making the spaghetti noodles.
