FRENCH DIP DAY IS HERE!

Beef. Bread. Broth. Maybe some cheese. Maybe some onions. That's all it takes to make a French Dip, one of the most mouthwatering sandwiches to ever come out of—not France—but California.

The French Dip is, basically, a roast beef sandwich on a French roll served with a side of broth into which the sandwich can (and should) be dipped. How did this get started? Glad you asked.

There are a bunch of theories, but the short version is that two L.A. restaurants are locked in a battle over who actually came up with the idea. **Philippe: The Original** claims they created it in 1918, while **Cole's** claims they figured it out in 1908. No matter, there are two versions of how the sandwich was created.

Theory #1—The Drop

The French Dip was created because a clumsy server accidentally dropped a perfectly normal roast beef sandwich into the meat cooking pan juices. The customer (either a police officer or a fire

fighter) took the sandwich anyway, liked it, and so it became a staple.

Theory #2—Bad Bread

A customer complained that the bread on their sandwich was stale. A roast beef sandwich was dipped in drippings to placate the customer either out of spite or out of kindness.
