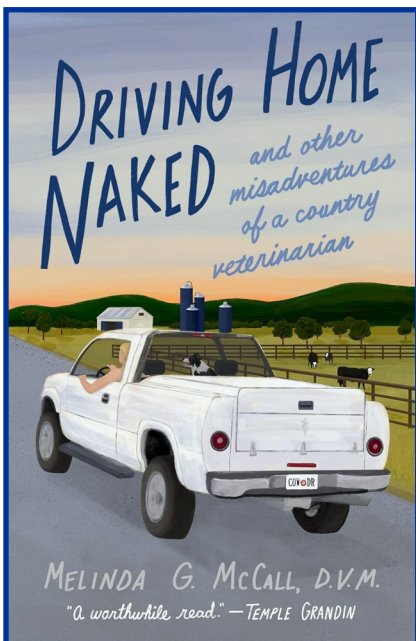

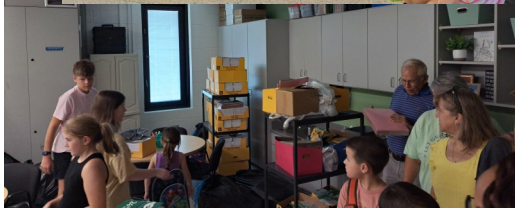

**This month: *Singing in the Christmas Cantata***

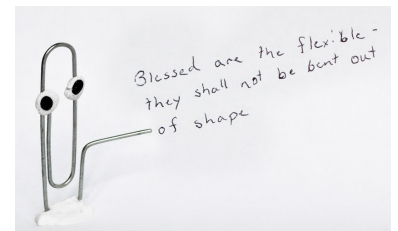
