Quick Facts:

- Fentanyl is the #1 killer of Americans ages 13-50.
- It is a synthetic opioid 50x more powerful than heroin & 100x more powerful than morphine.
- Only 2 mg (size of 3 grains of salt) is a lethal dose.
 - Fentanyl cannot be seen, smelled or tasted.
- It has been found in almost every "street" drug in SC.
- DEA estimates 40% of "street" drugs are laced with it.
 - Drug dealers use emojis when advertising it.
