## **NOTES FROM ED HEDGECOCK, CHAIR OF STEWARDSHIP/FINANCE:**

**The following notes highlight a few of the significant items in the 2025 Church budget.**

- The Church has seen a steady growth over the last year. This is reflected in several committees requesting an increase in their 2025 budgets. Additionally, any purchase by the Church in 2025 will see an increased cost.
- This next year will also require the Church to budget for both the tri-annual audit of the Church finances and the semi-annual in person NALC Convocation.
- All Church employees were given a 4% raise in salary for 2025. The Committee felt this was justified in part to an increased work load with our expanding membership. Additionally, the new full-time Youth and Young Adult position increased the staff expense. The Church has also had to adjust how we pay the Pastor's benefits to comply with Internal Revenue regulations which the Church has just become aware of.
